

After Reaching Bloomington-Normal

1. Open a bank account
2. Activate your ULID (if not yet active)
3. Get your Redbird Card (Student's ID, called UID) from Bone Students' Center
4. Register for courses which you received overrides for (see separate document with steps for course registration)
5. Visit the Students' Health Services (1st floor) to schedule an appointment for your immunizations then go to 2nd floor to set up your ISU insurance.
6. Get a letter of appointment from your GA's department that will help you apply for Social Security Number (SSN) (For GTAs you will receive this from HR and Dr. Meyer).
7. Take this letter of appointment/form to the Office of International Studies and Programs (OISP) (2nd floor, Fell Hall). The office will provide you with a form and any other important information that you will need to apply for SSN.
8. Remember to take the following with you to the SSN office:
 - a. Filled application forms (details of the forms will be provided by the OISP).
 - b. I-20
 - c. Birth Certificate
 - d. Passport/Visa
9. Attend the International Students Orientation; it is very helpful.
