

My name is Jack Glascock, associate professor in the School of Communication, and I am looking for graduate students (about 2 or 3) who might be interested in coding TV shows for physical aggression for a research project. The coding would be done over the summer. These shows were derived from an online survey asking college students to list their favorite TV shows. In total, there are about 60 shows, both half hour (i.e. Friends) and hour in length (i.e. Gray's Anatomy). The coding would consist of watching a portion of the shows and marking down each occurrence for physical (hitting, shooting at, etc.) aggression. Coding sheets listing all the different types of physical aggression would be provided. The compensation would be \$10 per hour.
